


### Year 2 Home school activities- Set 3

<p>Make a snazzy photo frame for your favourite picture. You could cut one out of cardboard and then decorate it!</p>	<p>Try to grow some seeds at home. If you don't have any seeds, you could use the tops of carrots or parsnips and sit them in wet kitchen paper on the windowsill. If you want to experiment further, why not try putting them in different places. Will they grow in the dark? With out water? Etc. Try to record your predictions.</p> 	<p>Could you build a ball run or a marble run to transport a marble or ball from one place to another?!</p> 	<p>Find out about the different continents of the world. What are they called? Can you name a country in each continent? Make up a dance to it and then teach it to your family!</p> 	<p>Hide your teddy in another room or the garden. Then draw, write or speak the instructions (an algorithm) for someone to find it. You need to be clear and precise with your instructions if you want teddy found quickly!</p> 	<p>Draw a picture of your garden.
