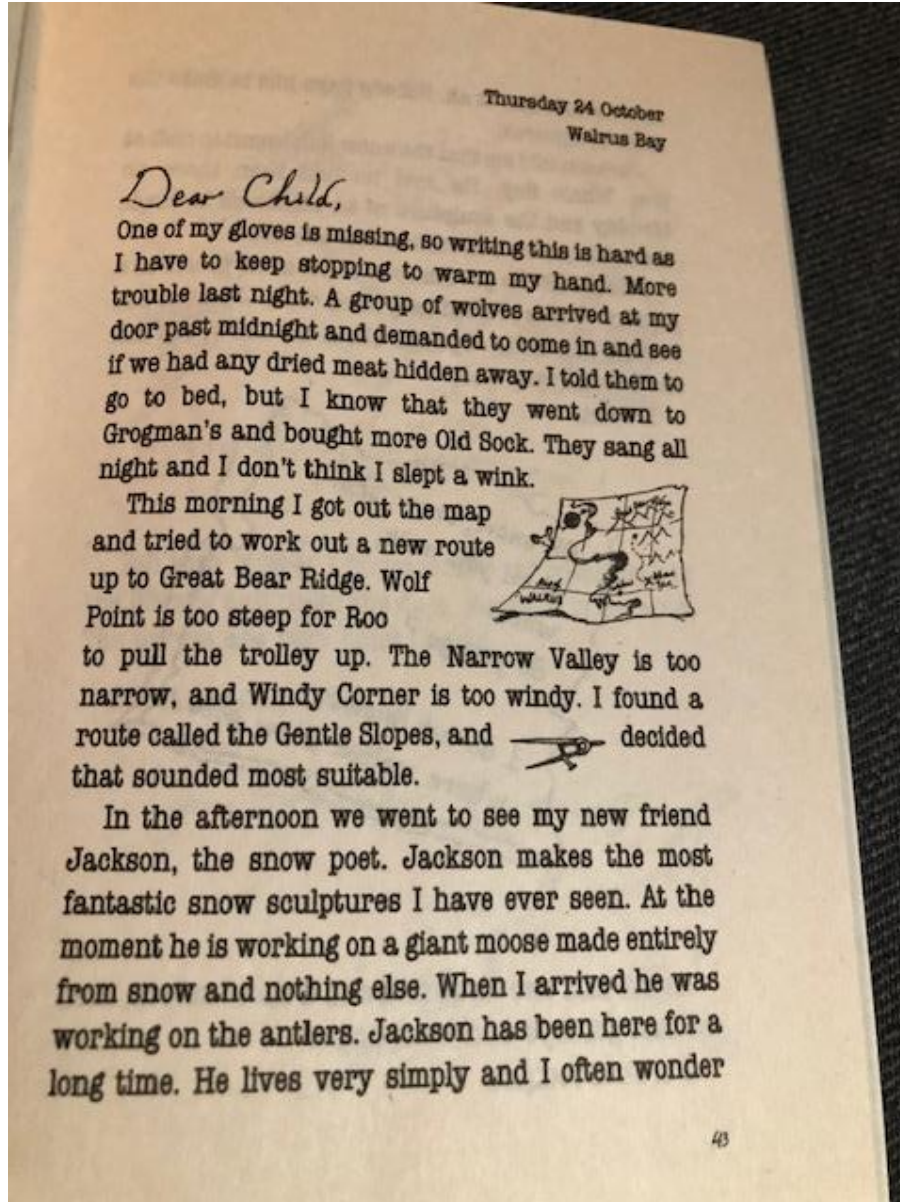


The Last Polar Bears by Harry Horse

3. What did Grandfather forget to do before he left for his expedition?

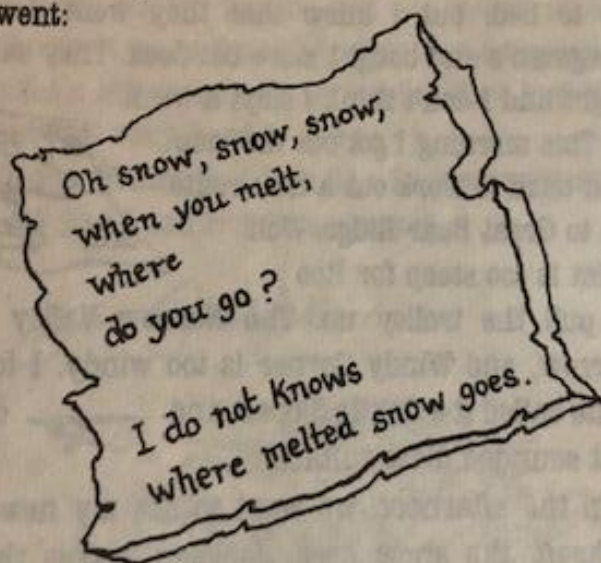


how he manages at all. Nobody pays him to make the snow sculptures.
