

English

Writing - This term the children will be looking at the key features of persuasive letter writing, non-chronological reports and fantasy stories. They will continue to plan, write, edit and improve their work, proof read for spelling and punctuation errors and respond to marking. They will be constantly reminded to use full stops and capital letters at all times and on the correct placement of letters in joined handwriting.

Reading - The children will continue to read from our class reading book. Please listen to your child at home as often as possible and talk to them about their books.

Homework – Buzz words and spellings will continue to be sent home weekly.

Maths

In Maths, the children will work on multiplying and dividing with 2, 5, 10, 3, 4 and 8 times tables and then formal methods of multiplication will be explored.

The children will work on measuring, comparing and converting units of length and then finding perimeters.

The children will practice recognising and writing fractions. They will find fractions of objects and numbers.

The children will look at money, pictograms, tables and bar charts.

Mental maths and times table practice will continue.

Computing

We are bug fixers– Children will learn to find and correct bugs in programs and explore ways to improve them.

We are designers – Children will develop their use of graphic and presentation skills and create effective layouts, combining text and images.

Rainforests – the children will discover where the rainforests are, what they are like, who lives in the Amazon Rainforest and some of the problems it faces.



Science

Animals (including humans) – the children will learn about nutrition as well as the function of skeletons and muscles.



Plants – the children will identify the functions of the different parts of a plant, find out what plants need in order to grow well.



P.E.

Games – the children will need a suitable kit for outdoor games every Thursday (eg. joggers, sweatshirt and trainers). Please include a pair of socks incase their feet get wet!

Art

Rainforest art - the children will draw and paint pieces of art inspired by rainforests.

Music

The children will explore and develop their playing skills using the glockenspiel. They will then learn about traditional Folk tunes from around the world.

The children will learn about colours, including likes and dislikes, before looking at different food and whether they are good or bad for your health.
