

SUMMER

English

Our English this term will be centred on the book Titanic – Death on the Water, by Tony Bradman. We will carry out research on passengers and write newspaper reports and balanced arguments. In **SPaG** lessons we will consolidate our learning and focus on applying more of what we know in our independent writing. We will continue with **spelling** lessons, recapping on patterns and rules for prefixes and suffixes. Reading **comprehension** lessons will be centred on sharing a book and will practice techniques to aid our understanding and appreciation of the texts that we read. The children will end each day by having a story read to them. They will also have regular slots in which to read their own books from home, independently. Please help your child to choose an appropriate text.

Maths

In Maths we will recap and secure our core skills knowledge and arithmetic methods. We will practice **mental maths** strategies through repetition and games. We will try to solve complex problems using bar modelling. We will also be recapping on all Y6 objectives using short flashback sessions and online learning games, quizzes and activities.

Computing

During computer sessions we will learn how to create and use spreadsheets effectively to show and manipulate data.

French

This term we will focus on days of week using 'aller', accommodation, transport and going on holiday.

This term we will research, design, make and evaluate our own mobile phone cases using felt. We will use two different types of stitching and add our own embellishments.

History
