

English



This term the children will learn various spelling strategies and comprehension skills will be developed through weekly sessions. During our work on stories and poems we will examine settings and characters to see how they have been developed by the author, while reading class novels. Children will practise planning and editing their own and each other's work. Grammar, punctuation and spelling will be a focus, together with handwriting and the presentation of work. Our non fiction topics will develop the children's understanding of the main features of newspaper articles and explanation texts.

Maths

During our mental maths activities we will be focusing on the use of number facts, times tables, place value, number patterns and sequences to aid addition and subtraction. Estimation skills, together with a range of mental and written methods for addition and subtraction, will be taught and practised this term. The children will learn how to round numbers to the nearest 10, 100 or 1000. They will also work on properties of shape and measurement, exploring length and perimeter. This term we will also begin investigative approach to learning and encourage pupils to develop their skills in problem solving and reasoning.



Science

Electrifying Electricity

Children will construct simple circuits using batteries, wires, bulbs, buzzers, switches and motors. They will recognise electrical conductors & Insulators and finally design & create working circuits, linked with D & T.

Sonic Sound

Children will identify how sounds are made and travel; and understand pitch through practical experiments. We will investigate absorbing sound & musical instruments.
