

## English

During this term we will start by studying the book 'There's a boy in the girls' bathroom' by Louis Sachar. While studying this book we will also be learning to write recounts and descriptive writing. We will also look at Greek Myths and will begin to write our own mythical stories based on them. We will write non-chorological reports about Ancient Greek Gods. We will finish the term with more descriptive writing, this time focusing on actions stories based on the short film 'The Oceanmaker.'



We will be starting this term by revisiting and consolidating place value, rounding numbers and decimals. We will be developing proficiency in formal written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

We will continue to develop our understanding of properties of shapes including finding the area and perimeter of shapes. We will also use a range of data handling skills including collecting, representing and interpreting data in line graphs. Then we will focus on reading tables such as train, bus and school timetables.

We will also continue to develop the range of mental calculation strategies we use and develop more efficient methods.

## Science

This term in science we will start by looking at forces such as gravity, resistance and magnetism as well as revisiting friction. We will test our understanding of the forces by launching rockets and overcoming or utilizing forces to aid their flight.

Later in the term we will be looking at the Earth and Space. We will look at the relationship between the Earth, Sun and Moon as well as the other planets in our solar system.

This term we will be looking at 'keeping safe.' During this topic we will look at habits, both good and bad; drugs; making decisions about their own safety and bullying.

The children will be involved in exploring different scenarios and discussing how to respond and what action they might take.

## Art

During art this term we will start by creating our own version of an Ancient Greek pot using papier-mâché. Later in the term we will be investigating mythical monsters and creating our own collaged creatures, inspired by Sara Fanelli.
